Thomas Cranmer, in the Preface to the Great Bible (1540) wrote:

Take the books into thine hands, read the whole story, and that thou understandest, keep it well in memory; that thou understandest not, read it again, and again. If thou can neither so come by it, counsel with some other that is better learned. Go to thy curate and preacher; show thyself to be desirous to know and learn, and I doubt not but God – seeing thy diligence and readiness (if no man else teach thee) – will himself vouchsafe with his Holy Spirit to illuminate thee, and to open unto thee that which was locked from thee.

Jesus, speaking about a most-precious verse from holy writ, commanded, “But go ye and learn what that meaneth.”

Homiletics is taught through oral and written assignments. If someone begins taking classes after the school year has started, then he or she will be expected to complete all of the first-year student assignments before the end of that school year.

## Rotating Curriculum

Potchefstroom Bible Institute (PBI) is an unaccredited school which works with a four-year, rotating curriculum. It is recommended that you start classes at the beginning of the school year. Due to the rotating nature of the curriculum, however, you can start classes at any time and still finish in only four years.

PBI offers a correspondence course, which allows you to choose the pace at which you would like to learn. For more information, contact the church office using the details on the back of this brochure.

You might be interested in one of the following:

### **Auditing Course**

- You can sit through all the classes without doing any assignments or writing any exams.
- Attendance is encouraged, but will be at your discretion.

### **Completion Course**

- All exams must be written and meet a standard of at least 70%, but no assignments are required to be written.

### **Degree Course (Bachelor of Divinity)**

- An average of 70% is necessary to pass each subject.
- At least 75% of classes must be attended.
- Three hours of public ministry in any month when classes are in session must be completed.
